1	BEd Program (Glendon Campus) – French Immersion and Core French This position is at the Primary/Junior/Intermediate/Senior level and requires a strong background in French Immersion, Extended and/or Core French. Candidates must have a strong generalist background in curriculum and instruction with recent classroom teaching experience and critical knowledge of current Ontario curriculum and policy. Candidates must be fluent and able to teach in both English and French.					
2	BEd Program – Indigenous Education This position is at the Primary/Junior/Intermediate level and requires a strong background in Indigenous education, including Indigenous traditions, histories and ways of knowing. Candidates must have expertise in curriculum and instruction across subject areas at the elementary level with recent classroom teaching experience, and critical knowledge of the Ontario curriculum and its impacts on Indigenous identity and experience in schools. Consistent with its fundamental commitments to equity, diversity and inclusion, and to promote the recruitment and appointment of Indigenous faculty members, the University welcomes applications from all qualified Indigenous candidates for this position.					
3	BEd Program – Elementary Education This position is at the Primary/Junior/Intermediate level and requires a strong generalist background in elementary education. Candidates must have expertise in curriculum and instruction across subject areas at the elementary level with recent classroom teaching experience and critical knowledge of the Ontario curriculum and policy.					

A seconded faculty member at the Faculty of Education at York University is expected to have kept abreast of new directions in curriculum and staff development and have knowledge of the Ontario context in which elementary or secondary schools operate. Seconded faculty members are also expected to have demonstrated leadership in school settings, to possess skills in mediation, and to have an understanding of, and experience in, equity issues, the use of educational research, supporting English language learners, inclusive education and technology as a teaching tool. The following activities may be a part of a seconded faculty member's responsibilities:

- Teaching courses that prepare candidates in the theory and practice of education;
- Co-ordinating and organizing programs;
- Working collaboratively, problem solving, and team building with other seconded, tenure stream, and contract faculty members;
- Supporting teacher candidates in their practicum settings;
- Continuing to build on and strengthening existing professional partnerships with boards, schools and community partners;
- Participating in the daily operation of the Faculty of Education (e.g. standing committees, working groups, admission process, special projects);
- Collaborating with the Faculty in research projects and in designing, evaluating, and improving our teacher education programs;
