The program's specific objectives are to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • advance research and scholarship on issues of intellectual, cultural and social importance by facilitating direct interaction among researchers and students, both from Canada and abroad; • promote research linkages among disciplines and across institutions, sectors and regions; and • enhance the visibility and profile of social sciences and humanities research. SSHRC Aid to Scholarly Journals	Up to \$30,000 per annum (3 years duration)	SSHRC recognizes that peer-reviewed scholarly journals are a primary tool for fostering intellectual debate and inquiry. The objective of the Aid to Scholarly Journals Program is to increase access to, and the readership of, original research results in the social sciences and humanities through Canadian scholarly journals. Through this program, SSHRC will contribute to the broad dissemination and impact of original research results in social science and humanities scholarship via Canadian scholarly journals. The program will also assist journals as they seek to take advantage of advances in communication technologies. Please note: York University Library has a whole program around online journals (York digital journals). Minor Research Grant, Faculty of Education	Maximum of \$2,500 for individual applications and \$5,000 for group applications	The purpose of these grants is to assist research projects which do not require major funding, including pilot studies or projects nearing completion. All full-time tenure-stream and seconded faculty, and research associates of the Faculty of Education are eligible.	May 1, 2008	Forms are listed on the Research Conference in the folder "Faculty of Education – Internal Forms"
SSHRC Grant in Aid of Travel	Up to Charter Class Airfare	To provide assistance to full-time social science and humanities faculty members and professional librarians to attend International Learned Conferences Abroad (i.e., outside Canada, U.S. and U.S. possessions) for which the applicant is giving a paper, or making a substantial presentation. York University researchers are reminded that all applications for external research funding, including Letters of Intent, must be reviewed and approved by the Office of Research Services before they are submitted to the granting agency. For internal approval, the application must be accompanied by a completed ORS Application Checklist, which requires the Chair's and Dean's signatures. To ensure that the approved application is ready by the agency deadline, a complete application folder must be submitted to the ORS ten (10) working days prior to final submission date.
