Requirements Information

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

The Graduate Diploma in Early Childhood Education gives formal recognition to those graduate students who have undertaken concentrated research and study concerning the education of young children (birth to age eight).

Choice of two options:

- Concurrent (Option A): The requirements for this Graduate Diploma are completed concurrently with a Master's or Doctoral degree.
- Direct-entry (Option B): This Graduate Diploma can be completed as a stand-alone non-degree diploma.
