### Approved Courses for Francophone Culture Credits (new BEd program)

Evaluations must be completed in French for courses taken to satisfy the BEd (French) requirement for 12 credits in Francophone culture courses. A minimum grade is not required. This means that any passing grade will be counted. We do, however, encourage students to take more Francophone culture courses than required to enhance their background prior to entering the teaching profession. Students will have to consult the Advising office of their home faculty for rules and regulations pertaining to their undergraduate degree. This list is updated annually.
